- **KENYA TRIP IN JULY:** Sarah, Rachel, her husband Royston and their son Theodore, and our newest Board Member Dennis make the trip to Kenya! We ran several workshops, training programs and got to personally visit dozens of the people we support in their homes across the Kawangware slum in Nairobi. It was special to be there all together and to gather and connect with families we support
- **WEI PROGRAM LAUNCH:** We have successfully launched our WEI microfinance program with groups in Nairobi, Siaya (up north) and Mombassa (at the coast). We look forward to providing more updates in the new year on their progress.
- HOLISTIC APPROACH TO SPONSORSHIP: This year we are proud of how we maintained our sponsorship model to ensure that the students have the best chance of success at school. Consistent home visits by our administrator Tim has ensured that students have a roof over their head, enough food at home and a stable and safe home life.
- INTRODUCTION TO HEALTH EDUCATION: With the help of Tim, our administrator and Tabitha long time friend and leader in the community we were able to host the first sessions on reproductive and sexual health for youth in the community for young boys and girls respectively. Due to cultural stigmas, reproductive health education and understanding does not leave the classroom, and is extremely lacking in detail. To best support our students and youth in the community, we provide a safe space for students to learn and ask questions so that we can prevent teenage pregnancies, promiscuity and abuse.
- CHRISTMAS MARKET SUCCESS: This year, for the first time in many, we were able to be a part of 4 different Christmas markets locally. We were able to fundraise over \$5500 through the sale of handmade products made by the talented artisans in Kenya. We are proud to be able to provide a market for their goods and in turn use the funds we raised to support them and their businesses once again.
